Dimensions

White 12x12 and 8-1/2 x 11

- 9 1/2" x 10" - 2 of these
 - On 9 1/2" side score at 5 1/4"
 - On 10" side score at 4 1/2" and 9"
- 4 1/2 x 4 1/2" for the top

Petal Pink

- 6-5/8/8" x 6 5/8" this is for the top -
 - score at 1" on all sides
- 4" x 4" also for the lid of the box
- 4 3/8" x 5-1/8" for the sides - 4 of these
- 4 3/8" x 4 3/8" for the bottom and inside of box - 2 of these

- 4 at 4 1/4" x 5" - 4 of these

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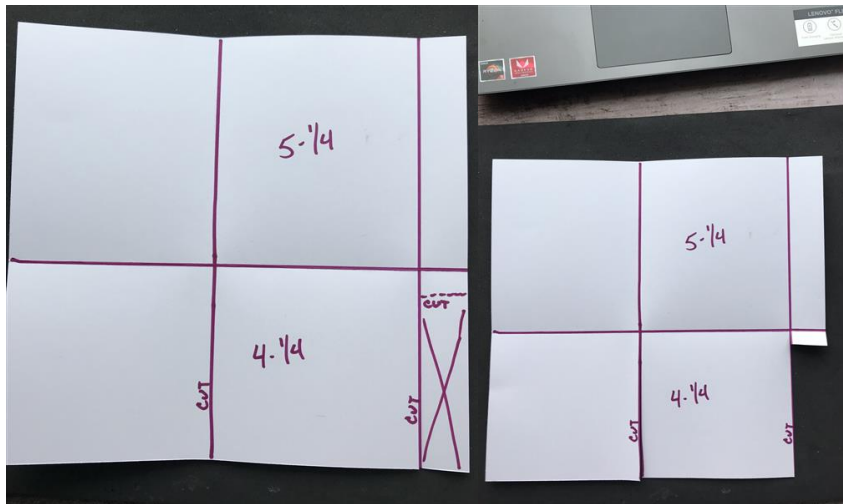
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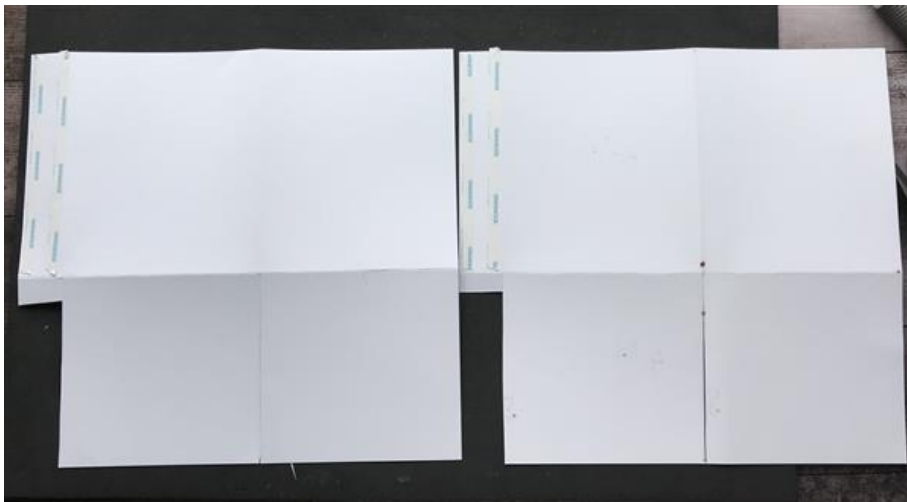
Step by Step

For the box base

1. after cutting and scoring all of your cardstock, fold and burnish all score lines.
2. cut up the 2 score lines on the short side. leave a 1/2 inch flap on the narrow piece and remove the rest. repeat on the other piece



3. flip both over and use tear and tape on the narrow flaps
4. adhere together to make the box sides



5. fold all four bottom flaps in with out tape to determine where tape should go. unfold three flaps and adhere tear tape to the inside. remove backing and put box bottom together. make sure to keep the box square. push your hand down on the inside to secure the flaps
6. with tear tape add the cardstock piece to the outside of the bottom. This will cover the entire bottom and make it uniform. Do the same for the inside.

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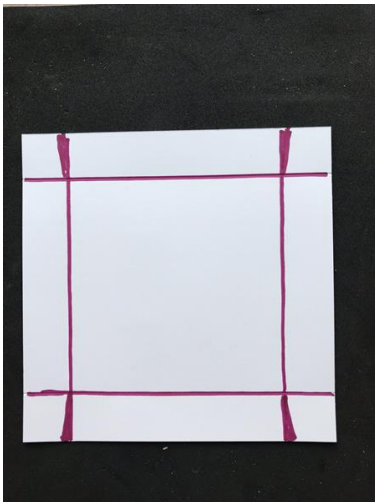
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7. layer the vellum on the cardstock pieces then adhere them to the box. it should be as close to the bottom of the box as possible. If there is any gap at the top, it will be covered by the lid
8. insert your tissue box. It should fit snugly.



For the lid

1. fold and burnish on all score lines. cut up each of the four corners and notch the flaps



2. layer the whisper white piece in the center. Using the big shot to cut the second largest oval from oval framelits. you will need to fold in the sides of the box lid in order to fit in the bigshot but it wont cut the sides.
3. adhere the petal pink cardstock in the center of the lid with just a small amount of tape runner with the sticky removed - tap it with your finger or rub it on your clothing. You want to be able to remove this piece. With the cardstock on the lid, flip it over and use a pencil to draw around the inside of the oval. remove the cardstock and ut it out using the largest scalloped oval die and

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the pencil mark. replace the cardstock with full strength tape runner to box lid. your ovals should line up perfectly, with the scalloped being slightly larger than the whisper white.



4. complete the box lid by adhering the flaps
